## **2<sup>nd</sup> Announcement**

### **Background and objective**

EAAP Mountain Livestock Farming Working Group (MLF), FAO-CIHEAM Mountain Pastures Sub-Network (MP) and University of Ljubljana are promoting a joint meeting focused on the topic of the mountains in the function of agroecosystems for people. A broad range of topics related to farming in mountain areas, precision mountain farming, smart agriculture (digitalisation), mountain product quality, value chains, management options for ecosystem services and conflicting priorities in mountain areas (wild animals, natural resources and human needs) will be covered during the meeting. Therefore, research contributions of all disciplines relevant to mountain livestock farming are welcome. The gathering of participants from different regions across Europe is expected to stimulate the exchange of knowledge, promote innovation and thus enabling the expertise to be bundled and implemented on a local level throughout Europe.

### **Programme**

The meeting will be held in Bled, Slovenia. It will last three days, providing a forum for scientific and technical exchanges and a one-day field trip.

The scientific sessions will be structured on five topics with a concluding session. They will consist of conferences presented by keynote guest speakers and free contributions as oral presentations and posters. Meeting sessions will consider the following topics:

1. Farming systems and global change
2. Precision mountain farming and smart agriculture
3. Product quality and value chains
4. Management options for ecosystem services
5. Conflicting priorities in mountain areas: wild animals, natural resources and human needs

We kindly invite scholars from all over Europe to submit an extended abstract of one page and present at the meeting their work on the five topics above. The working language of the meeting will be **English**.

A book of abstracts collecting all the abstracts accepted by the scientific committee will be available at the meeting and on the website of the conference.

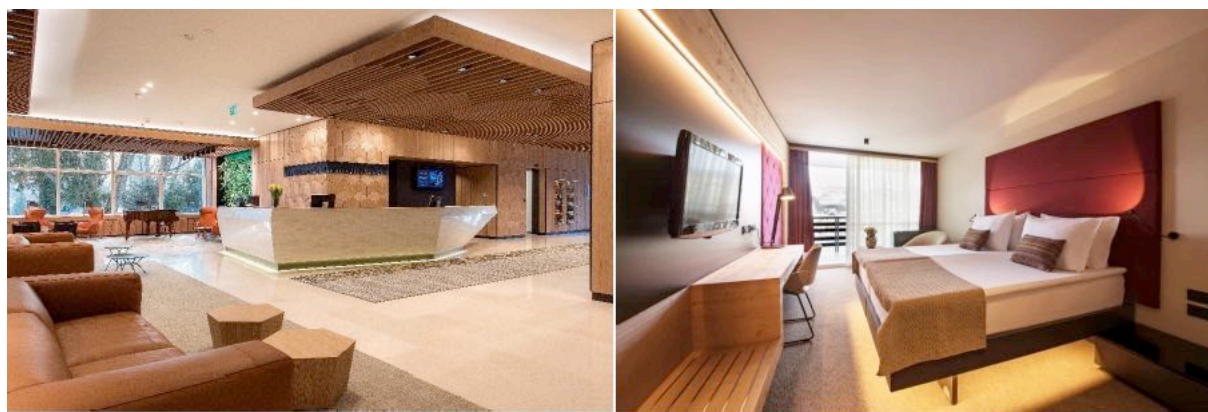
Hotel booking is guaranteed by the Meeting organisers until August 10<sup>th</sup>, 2020.

**Keywords:** Maximum 5 keywords

**Introduction:** Please provide a short introduction to the background for your work. References may be included in the text like this: (Ricardo et al., 2017) but there is no room for a reference list in the extended abstract. Please prepare a full reference list if readers are interested at the meeting. The introduction should end with the aim of the study and/or defined hypotheses for your paper. Use Times New Roman font size 10,5 in main text. Use single line space throughout the text and skip one line between sessions.

**Materials and methods:** Please provide a short description of the materials and methods that form the basis of your study. If you present a literature review, please describe the data gathering process and the sources you have used.

**Results:** Please provide the main results from your study. Results may be presented as a short table or figure if you find it informative but, please, remember that you only have the space of one page, within the set line limits in this template. If results are presented with the use of tables or figures the legends should be self-explanatory. Table or figure legends should be Times New Roman font size 10.

**Conclusion:** Please provide a short conclusion from your study.
